Introduction

The Android SDK provides us with various capabilities that allow us implementing instant messaging capabilities into our application.

GTalk Support

- The Android SDK first releases includeed the support for using the GTalk messaging service from within our code.
- Due to security reasons that support was removed.

Wi-Fi Direct

- Wi-Fi Direct allows android devices to connect directly to each other via Wi-Fi without an intermediate access point.
- The support for Wi-Fi direct was added into the Android 4.0 platform and it requires specific hardware.
- Using the Wi-Fi Direct APIs, you can discover and connect to other devices across distances much longer than a Bluetooth connection.

Session Initiation Protocol

- The Android platform supports the Session Initiation Protocol (SIP). It includes a full SIP protocol stack.
- We can use the SIP protocol for developing VOIP applications.
