- ❖ We define the animation using the `@keyframes` rule.

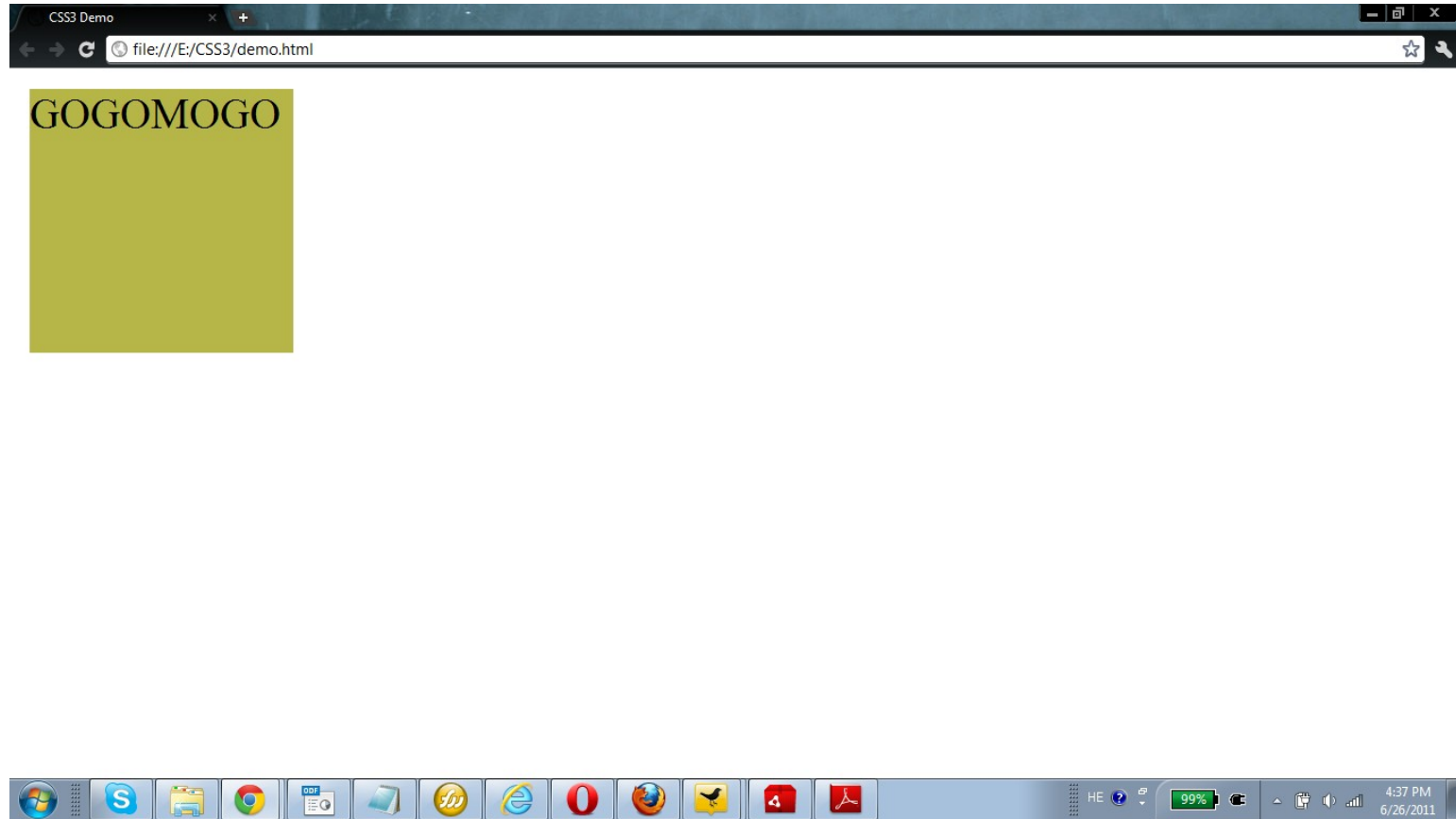
