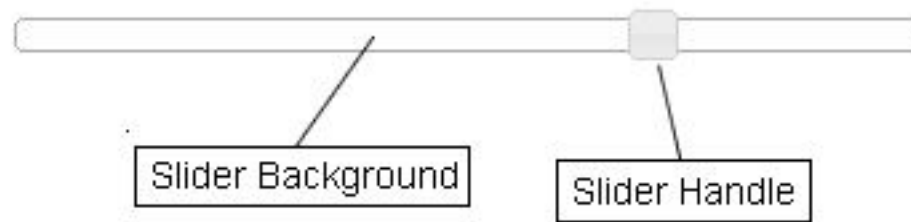


Slider

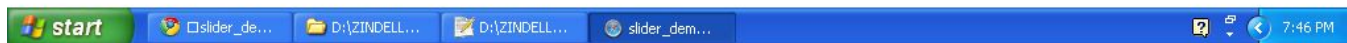
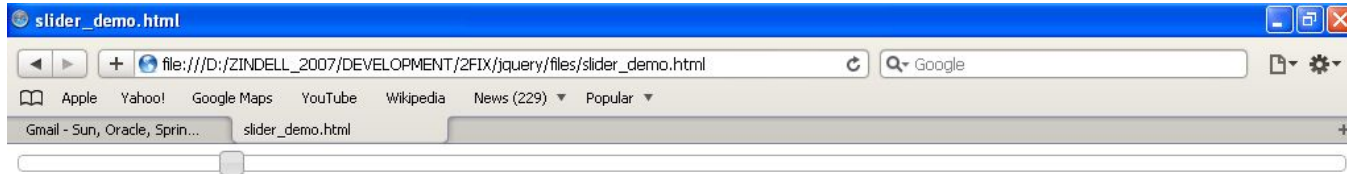

Slider Smoothness

- ❖ We can set the slider smoothness by using the `animate` property. The value of this property can be one of three possible types.
- ❖ It can be `true` or `false` in order to indicate whether the animation even takes place.
- ❖ It can be `“slow”`, `“normal”` or `“fast”` in order to indicate how fast the animation takes place.

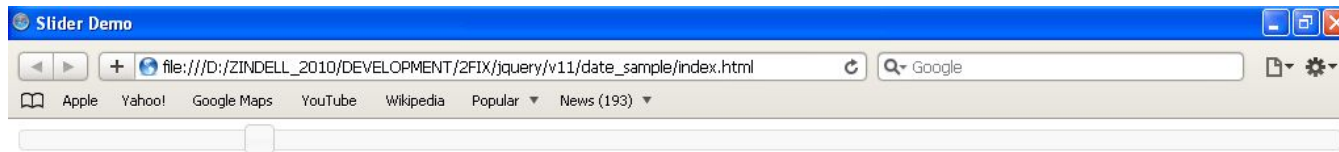
Slider Smoothness

- ❖ It can be a number specified in milliseconds in order to specify how long it will take for the animation to complete.

Slider Range

- ❖ We can set the slider range using the `min` and `max` properties.

```
...  
$(function()  
{  
    var vec = {min:100, max:1000};  
    $("#myslider").slider(vec);  
});  
...
```

Slider Events

- ❖ The `start` event takes place when the user starts moving the slider.
- ❖ The `slide` event takes place with each and every move of the slide.
- ❖ The `change` event takes place when the slide stops its move or when its value is changed programmatically.
- ❖ The `stop` event takes place when the user stops the sliding.

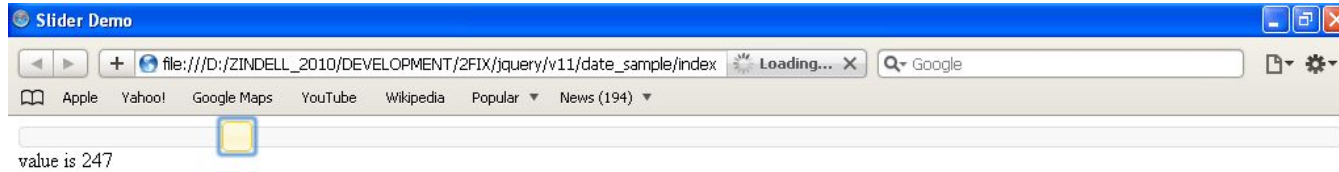

Multiple Handles

- ❖ We can create a slider with more than one handle by specifying within the `<div>` element on which we are building up the slider `<div>` child elements for each one of the handles we want to have. In each one of them we should specify the `ui-slider-handle` class.

```
<div id="my_slider">  
<div class="ui-slider-handle"></div>  
<div class="ui-slider-handle"></div>  
</div>
```

Multiple Handles

- ❖ Using the `values` property we can specify the initial values of our handles.

```
...  
$(function()  
  {  
    var vec = {min:100, max:1000, values:[200,300]};  
    $("#myslider").slider(vec);  
  });  
...
```
